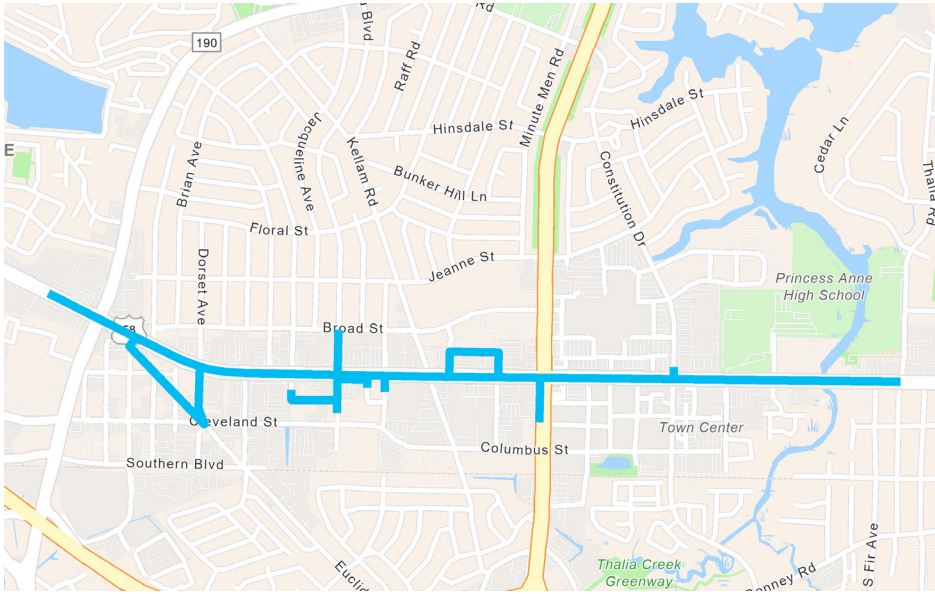


Virginia Beach Blvd and Euclid SAVE
